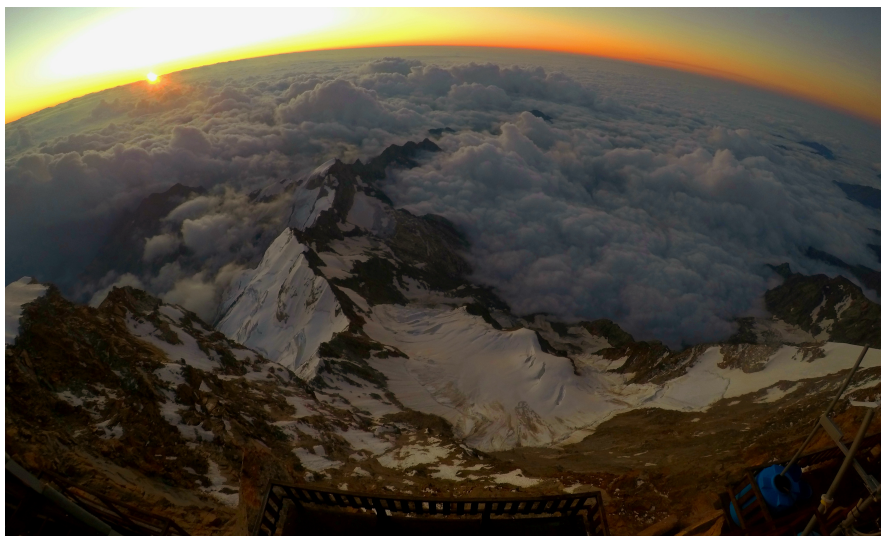




Considered one of the most beautiful and famous ridges in the Alps, it separates the Alagna Valley (Valsesia) from that one of Macugnaga (Anzasca Valley) and is a ridge that brings back emotions of the past.

Exposed to the east, it is immediately kissed by the sun which makes it exciting and fun but for its length of approach and development it should absolutely not be underestimated, good training is needed... and all this makes the adventure wild.

Climbing Program

Day 1: Climb to the Resegotti hut 3624 m, passing by the Barba Ferrero refuge where you take a lunch break.

Day 2: wake up at dawn to attack the crest, bypassing some gendarmes and going through some passages on the East of the Rosa, you reach the ledge where, by going along it and exiting on the south face, you can see the Capanna Margherita. The last slopes will lead us to the highest refuge in Europe Mt 4554.
