



Stage Margherita

The Alpine Guides of our staff propose a three-day approach to the climb to Capanna Margherita, a short technical and acclimatization course even for people with little mountaineering experience.

Our training course has as its main objective to make the climb to the "Highest Refuge in Europe" pleasant, first of all to be able to acclimatize as best as possible by staying longer at high altitude and reaching the top of some "4000" in the Monte Rosa massif first.

During the day of preparation for the summit we will deepen the technical knowledge and correct use of crampons and ice axe "cramponage" and of roped progression.

Day 1:

meeting in the morning with the Alpine Guide in Alagna Valsesia, material check and climb with lifts to Punta Indren, technical and acclimatization day near the Garstelet glacier. Overnight stay at the Gnifetti Refuge (3647 Mt.).

Day 2:

from the Gnifetti Refuge with a circular route we will reach the top of the Vincent Pyramid (4215 m) and of the Christ of the Peaks (4167 m) subsequent return to Capanna Gnifetti where we will spend the second night.

Day 3:

early departure from the Refuge and along the long development of the Lys glacier we will reach the top of Capanna Margherita, stop for about 1 hour at the top and return for the same itinerary to Punta Indren. Descent with facilities to Alagna Valsesia.
